The Netherlands has so many worthwhile places and attractions to visit and a comprehensive and well-constructed itinerary can be easily created.

Our groups stay in Noordwijk, an attractive coastal town which is an ideal base for exploring the cities of Amsterdam and Rotterdam. It is in the heart of the Dutch Bulb growing area, close to Delft, the Hague and the dams of the Delta region.

Optional visits

Aalsmeer.

The world's largest flower auction (Monday to Friday mornings only), distributing 14 million flowers worldwide, everyday.

Alkmaar.

Historic old town with traditional Cheese market held every Friday morning (April to Sept), with porters wearing historical costumes.

Kinderdijk.

A well preserved, fascinating gang of 19 windmills from 18th Century, built to drain the Albasserwaard polders.

DeEfteling.

One of Europe's most visited amusement parks suitable for all ages and where a world full of miracles becomes reality.

Delft.

A beautiful medieval town famous for the Delft Blue Pottery, a craft which is still practiced today.

Spido Cruise, Rotterdam.

Take a 75 minute cruise around the busy international harbour and port and see the city from the vantage of a glass-roofed boat.

Madurodam.

A Dutch city built to 1/25 of its actual scale. A great variety of buildings, including the Dutch Parliamentary Buildings (the 'Binneenhof') and Schiphol Airport are on display here.



Euromast.

Travel to the top of the 185 metre high Euromast, Rotterdam and enjoy a spectacular panoramic view of the city, port and surroundings.

Clara Maria Cheese Farm.

The farm is set in the pastoral polder landscape just southwest of Amsterdam. This 150-year old farm creates an inviting atmosphere for visitors to step back into old world charm.

Corpus.

The world's most unique and interactive attraction with an ingenious sensory experience. Embark on a journey through the human body in an original and informative way.

Viissengen.

Visit the Bunkerbehold near Middelburg. A series of underground bunkers from the Second World War and accompanying museum.

Duinrell.

Aqua Theme Park with indoor sub tropical 'Tiki Pool'.

Day 1

Ratterman Clog Makers.

Watch a demonstration of clog making at this traditional factory and learn about the history, origins and techniques of making authentic Dutch wooden shoes.

Anne Frank Museum, Amsterdam.

Visit the site of Anne Frank's house and learn about the persecution she, her family and friends endured during the war, told through her diary.
